Mayor Greg Stanton & City Officials Will Speak; Eco-Hub Will Provide Direct Access To City Experts On Incentives, Programs & Sustainable Best Practices

Nov. 15, 2012 (PHOENIX) — GoGreen Phoenix, brought to you by the city of Phoenix and presented by Arizona Public Service (APS), takes place Thursday, Dec. 6, 2012, at the LEED Silver Phoenix Convention Center. During the second annual sustainable business conference, the city will showcase its extensive green business initiatives, incentives and programs.

Experts from the city — including Energize Phoenix, Public Works, Water Services, and the Office of Environmental Programs, Aviation, Phoenix Convention Center, Neighborhood Services, Parks and Recreation and Planning and Development Services — will offer actionable next steps for attendees.

The city of Phoenix offers local businesses a variety of services to implement sustainable practices that benefit the community, the environment and their own bottom line. The city recognizes the strength of public/private partnerships with our business community having partnered with businesses to provide \$477 million in outsourced services last year.
